

ART SCAMS

Even though we all want to sell our work (after all that's why we have web sites), we have to be very careful of the scammer. This is a typical example of one. One thing to watch for is bad spelling, bad use of English and using asap as they think that is what we Americans do. If you sell your paintings over the internet, only go through Pay Pal for the money and never ship a painting until you have assurance from Pay Pal the money is there. Here's a typical scam:

Hello

Good day, My name is David Campbell. I hope this message finds you well. I was going through your works and (names of paintings) caught my eye, i will like to have it for my new apartment. I want the apt absolutely ready asap, So please let me know if the piece is available, if yes, then let me have the detailed price and more information about the piece. i will be waiting to read from you asap.

Kind Regards.

(this message after artist replies)

Hello,

Thanks for the message, I am very happy to know that you have a Artwork that is still available for sale. i must tell you i am very much interested in the immediate purchase and i am willing to pay the asking price (\$350). please send me the pics, but anyway i will be buying it.

I will like to let you know that your payment will be in a Certified Check and i will wait till it clears your bank before telling my shipper to come for the pick up, this will not take time at all because the payment will be sent out immediately i read back from you. You don't have to worry about shipment, my shipper will handle it. This is because i am currently out of the states on a business proposal. So get back to me with the information needed to send you the payment I:E:

Full Name

Standard Address (no p.o box)

Phone numbers

so that i can proceed in the payment arrangement. I will like you to consider it sold get back to me asap with needed information.
