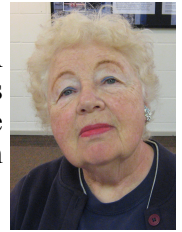

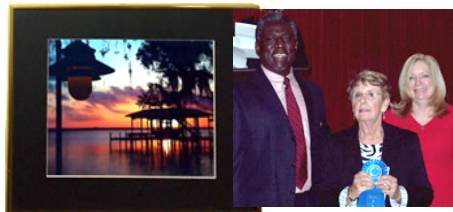

The paintings were juried and judged by Judith Rogers and the winners were:

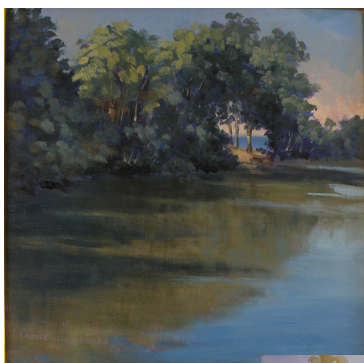

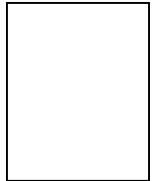
