Tarpon Springs Art Festival - March 31, April 1, 2012

Bring your work to be registered on Friday, March 30, to the parking lot at 400 S. Walton Ave. (our regular meeting place) from 10 to 11:30 AM. For \$10.00 you may enter 2 wired works for hanging and up to 6 wrapped pieces for the browse bins. The paintings may be no larger than 18×24 inches, including the frame, or 432 square inches, and no smaller than 8×10 inches. You also must have signed up to work either registering, transporting, hanging, or sitting for the show. All work must be picked up between 4:30 and 5:00 PM on Sunday. This show is sponsored by the Tarpon Springs Chamber of Commerce and if we want to continue having a free entry into the show, we have to follow their rules. Keep it clean and dignified.

REMEMBER you need your TSAA ID card to get into this show for free. If you don't have it yet, you may pick it up when you register.

<u>April Show – April 2 – Heritage Museum</u> – The April meeting will include the installation of officers, a pot luck picnic, and the art show at the Heritage Museum. The association will provide the beverages, tableware, etc., and the members should bring a pot luck dish to serve six to be shared.

The artwork should be at the Museum by 10:30 as it will be judged by an outside judge from 11:00 to 12:00. The work must be an original (not produced in a workshop), never before shown in a TSAA show, hangable, and preferably, have an easel on which to show it. The Museum no longer has easels.

Mitch Kolbe will demonstrate in oil, plein air, during the judging. The artwork will then be hung in the Performing Arts Center, so all who wish to hang at the Performing Arts Center will be responsible for delivering their piece there. It will stay there for one month, coming down on April 30. Please obey the copyright laws and make your work your own.

There is <u>no entry fee</u> for this show and there will be ribbons and prize money for awards, so please let's all enter.

After the awards are given, we ask all winners to stand by their painting for picture taking, before they are all removed to go to the Performing Arts Center.
