The exhibit will remain intact until Tuesday, December 30, 2014. Pick-up will be from 10:00am to 12 noon. If you cannot pick up your art on this day, please arrange for someone to pick it up for you.

Thursday, January 08: 10:00am take down decoration.

RULES

1. One piece of current <u>original</u> framed artwork per member. Artwork must never have been shown before in a TSAA show, a copy of an award winning piece, or done in a class.

- 2. Two dimensional works must be wired and ready to hang. (or they won't be hung)
- 3. TSAA has the right to refuse any work deemed unsuitable, i.e. nudes.
- 4. Maximum size shall not exceed **48 inches** in any dimension, including FRAME. (we will not hang anything larger)
- 5. Entries must remain for the entire show. (NO EXCEPTIONS)
- 6. In the event of a sale the artist will donate 20% to the Cultural Center.
- 7. Payment of a \$10.00 entry fee will be collected at registration.

Only 2014 members are eligible for the show. You must have paid your dues before January 2014 and the November 2014 meeting to be eligible. No late entries accepted.

PLEASE REMEMBER to complete your registration forms **BEFORE** you come to register. There are three small forms on one sheet of paper. (See next issue) You will keep one and place one on the back of the artwork and TSAA keeps the third.

All art must be ready to hang. We cannot repair frames that are not secure. It is the artist's responsibility to have a secure frame and hanging wire.

Display locations are **<u>final</u>**. It is not possible to move art if the artist wants a different display location.

The rules of the show have been adopted after years of work. Please follow them and we will have a positive exhibit experience.

1. Oil, (oil) 2. Acrylic (acr) 3. Watermedia (wm) (Watercolor and Acrylic under glass) 4. Mixed Media (mm) 5. Color Pencil/Pen & Ink (cp) 6. Photography (ph) 7. Pastel/Charcoal (pa) 8. 3 Dimensional (3d)

Prizes will be Best of Show, Joe Gonzales People's Choice Award, and each category may have first, second, third and 3 honorable mentions. Awarding the prizes is at the discretion of the judge. It is possible that not all prizes will be awarded.
