President's Message by Sherry Orr

February is a great month to work in the cool sunshine. Not to forget those wonderful strawberries from Plant City. Maybe we should take a Plein Air trip to the strawberry fields?

Meanwhile, Heather is working hard setting up the Paint and Photo Plein Air Event in April. She is selling ads for the handbook. If anyone knows a business that might buy an ad, please contact her. It is not too early to sign up to participate in

this event.

We appreciate your ideas and support during our discussion on finances. Our goal is to retain all of our current activities at the same level. We have had an increase in expenses with some necessary expenses. A couple of years ago we bought liability insurance at a cost of \$1,300.00. We purchased new chains and clips for the Winter Show. The monthly demonstrations cost us \$50. to \$100.00. The newsletter costs us \$15.00-\$200.00 a month. The receptions cost us around \$80.00 an event. The ribbons and awards cost approximately \$1,300.00 for our bigger events.

Currently, we pay \$20.00 for a membership. With that membership you have an opportunity to attend demonstrations and workshops. Venues are available to hang your work. The Winter Show, Artist Faire, Art on the Bayou, and Spring Show. Yes, we do have some entrance fees. The good news is that if you sell a work, we do not take a percentage. We have access to weekly Plein Air workshops.

The Board is proposing the following increases. In 2017, the dues will increase by \$5.00. The Winter Show entry fee will increase by \$10.00. The Art on the Bayou will increase by \$10.00.

After checking with other Art Associations in the area, our Association has the lowest costs.

Coming up is the People's Choice Show at the Artist Faire. Work should be registered on February 15 and will hang at the gallery until February 26th. This is great exposure. There are usually over 200 visitors seeing our work.

We continue to mentor the 50 students at the Boys and Girls Club. This project is funded by a grant from Walmart. This past month the students drew bicycles using colored pencils and wrapped a bicycle in colorful yarn. Thank you to our volunteers...Frank Hipp, Terri Gonzalez, Bess King, Patsy Renz, Heather Risley, Lynn Kopala, and Sherry Orr!

Look forward to seeing you on February 1st!
