Saying our farewell to our past president Sherry Orr. (She looks a little too happy about leaving the job, I think). She did promise to volunteer whenever we need someone though.









Originally from Arizona, Terry Denson has lived in many parts of the United States and the eastern and western Caribbean and currently resides in St. Petersburg, FL.

She studied drawing at the Maryland Institute, College of Art in Baltimore and at other institutions, and has attended workshops with a number of prominent artists throughout the United States. She began studying watercolor in 1995, shortly before beginning a six year sailboat cruise of the Eastern U.S., Bahamas, Caribbean, & Central America. Seeking a medium that fit the limited space aboard her sailboat, *Door Into Summer*, she chose watercolors.

After returning to land life she settled in Saint Petersburg and expanded her painting to acrylics and oils but transparent watercolors remain her primary medium. In 2003 she became a full-time artist.

She is a popular teacher and watercolor workshop instructor. She has displayed in numerous outdoor art festivals and organizational exhibitions throughout the country where she has received a number of awards. She is a signature member of the Florida Watercolor Society and the Kentucky Watercolor Society. Her paintings have been used as promotional materials by the Southern Watercolor Society, the Florida Watercolor Society, Florida Nursery Growers and Landscape Association, and several art festivals throughout Florida.
