The entry fee is \$20.00. One piece of art work should be entered. Paintings cannot be more than 48 inches in any dimension, including FRAME. (we will not hang anything larger) and no smaller than 8 x 10. All media can be entered in this show including three dimensional.

If an artist has placed first, second, third or Best of Show during 2016, that specific award winning piece that won in a Tarpon Springs Art Association show cannot be entered into this show.

Hanging Art: 12:00 noon - until done

November 16th: Judging

November 17th: Reception 6:00 pm—presents of awards 7:00 pm

Please bring finger foods between 5 - 5:30 pm

No food or drinks in the auditorium

December 30th: Pick up Art Work and Take down decorations. 10:00 a.m.- 12:00 noon

If a work is sold, 20% is donated to the Cultural Center by the artist. The Art Work remains at the Show until December 30th.

RULES

1. One piece of current **original** framed artwork per member. Artwork must never have been shown before in a TSAA show, a copy of an award winning piece, or done in a class.
2. Two dimensional works must be wired and ready to hang. (or they won't be hung)
3. Entries must remain for the entire show. (NO EXCEPTIONS)
4. In the event of a sale the artist will donate 20% to the Cultural Center.

Only 2016 members are eligible for the show. You must have paid your dues for 2016 by the November meeting to be eligible. If you are not sure, go to our web site and check if your name is on the member list. No late entries accepted.

Raquel Egosi was in the Hard Lox festival in Asheville NC and sold 5 paintings


