ARTIST OF THE MONTH. This is not a time-consuming position. You would just need to set the art up before the meeting begins, no later than 1:15 so that members will have time to vote. Also, you would need to set out the voting slips of paper and pencils. After the meeting begins, you would count the votes and then announce the winner at the end of the meeting.

REFRESHMENTS CHAIR. This is also an easy position. You would need to come early to make the coffee and set up the refreshment table, and then straighten up after the meeting is over. You would also make a list of people who will bring refreshments for the meeting. People have always traditionally been willing to help with setting up and cleaning up.

VENUE CHAIR FOR THE PUBLIC ART CENTER (CITY HALL). 12 pictures are needed to hang in the Performing Arts Center (PAC). These are changed every 2 months and we ask 3 people to bring 4 pictures. No glass in frames is allowed, and the art cannot exceed 16x20 in size, framed. This is not a difficult or time-consuming job at all, and it is a good venue. Many people attend the productions and have the opportunity to view your art. Please contact me for details.

# An opportunity to take art classes at St Pete College!

For those of us who are 60 years old or older, and meet the Florida residency requires for tuition purposes, it is possible to take art classes at many Florida colleges and universities at low or no cost. Here's how to go about that, at our local St Pete College! (Note that not all classes are taught at the Tarpon Campus; some are in Clearwater.) As a student with a seniors waiver, you will not get formal credit toward a degree. (Degree-seeking students of any age must pay tuition.) But it's a nice opportunity to learn some new things, polish up our skills, and/or get inspired! For studio classes, there may be an equipment fee, which you would have to pay.

How to do this? First you have to apply and pay the \$40 application fee as a new student, but this is a one-time only cost, and lasts as long as you want to take classes (which can be over a period of years). Then you look at the schedule, and if the class you want is not filled by the last Friday before the term starts, you must go in person to the office (not exactly sure where this is) and get a senior waiver of tuition. Then you can take the class. In recently trying to do this, one of our members "hit a couple snags": The print-making class she wanted to take requires that you take drawing 101 first, so be sure to check whether there are prerequisite classes. Another thing is that the senior tuition waiver was Aug 12, at which she was out of town. Typically it's the Friday before classes begin, so you'll need to pay attention to the dates and put this one on your calendar. The good news is that some of the classes WILL be taught at the Tarpon Springs campus. The next opportunity is January, so you may want to start looking into it this fall.

A high resolution photo must be available for printing if the art work is chosen. Artists will be paid a \$100 honorarium for images chosen. One image per artist. The artist will retain the original work. Final selections will be made by PAC: Tuesday, October 12, 2022. Selected artists will be notified via email following the PAC meeting


