# Fine Arts Festival 2025 March 7, 8, and 9

# The 50th Annual Fine Arts Festival will be held at Craig Park on March 8 and 9. TSAA registration is March 7.

This year is the 50th Anniversary of the Fine Arts Festival; Tarpon Springs Art Association started the festival...50 years ago! Now the Chamber of Commerce sponsors it. And that is why TSAA members get into the festival free! Also, the tent space is at no charge to TSAA!

Each member of TSAA has the opportunity to exhibit up to three pieces of artwork to hang in the tent and up to 10 bin pieces. Hanging artwork must be properly wired with artist name, email, phone number on the back. Bin pieces must be flat and have name, phone number and email as well as price visibly displayed. We ask that artwork be no smaller than 8 x 10 and no larger than 18 x 24.

Registration is \$10, and will be on Friday, March 7 at the Community Center (where we have our general meetings, but in a different room) from 10 to 12 noon. Registration will include completing a form listing the artwork, prices, medium and completing tags for artwork. The tents will be set up as the registration is going on and artwork will be left at the community center to be transported to Craig Park and hung in the tents once registration is done. The area will be guarded, and secure so artwork can be left in the tents overnight.

We have a couple of spots along the water, near the food and entertainment. These spots were new to us last year and we had a number of sales! If the artist is not present when a sale is made, unless we know the person (like maybe a member of TSAA), no checks will be accepted...only the artist will be able to say yes to accepting a check. We can accept credit cards — and of course cash is always good!

The Square is what TSAA uses for credit card sales. In the event the square is used, the artist will receive the amount of the sale minus a small fee that the Square charges. No commissions will be taken by TSAA.

Where to park? Behind Tarpon Tower, the 6 or 7 story white building you can see off US 19 and Martin Luther King St. There is a free shuttle for transportation to Craig Park. It will run til 5 pm... but probably not later!

Pick-up of unsold artwork: 5 pm at the Festival at the tents...or around 6 or 6:30 pm at the Community Center parking lot.
